

Katikati College Curriculum Policy

RATIONALE:

To ensure the development and delivery of a quality curriculum that conforms to the requirements of the NZ Curriculum supported by effective teaching.

GUIDELINES:

- 1. A school wide curriculum plan will be maintained and developed through a process of consultation with all stakeholders.
- The development of the curriculum will be consistent with the NZ Curriculum, NAGs and the Charter and will be maintained through regular review with a view to incorporate the NELPS.
- The curriculum offered will be collaboratively developed and approved by the Principal and Senior Leadership Team. Any developments will be regularly reported to the Board of Trustees.
- 4. Ongoing teacher professional development will be provided to ensure successful curriculum delivery.
- 5. An up-to-date Staff Assessment Manual will be reviewed annually, and relevant staff will be expected to follow the guidelines as stated in this manual.
- 6. Student assessment information will be shared with parents in a timely fashion.
- 7. Procedures will be in place to identify students with special needs and provide them with the appropriate internal and external support they require (This includes students requiring extension).
- 8. Ongoing career guidance and education will be provided for all students NAG1 vi).
- 9. To foster independent study habits, organisational skills and to reinforce classroom learning, homework is regarded as an important part of the curriculum.
- 10. The Board recognises the importance of parental support.
