STAGE 1 - Behaviour can be managed by the adult involved - Teacher, HOF notified

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- Damage to school property
- Disruption (INTERRUPTING LEARNING)
 - Calling out
 - Eating / chewing
 - Inappropriate noises
 - Off task behaviour
- Inappropriate language
- Late to class
- Non-compliance (NOT FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS)
 - Lack of equipment
 - Not working in class
 - Leaving class early
 - Mobile device out in class (without approval)
 - Choosing to ignore instructions
- Performing below the expected standard
 - Absent from assessment
 - Assessment is late or not handed in
 - Homework not completed
 - Non-completion of classwork
- Physical contact
 - Non-serious but inappropriate

POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES

Remember to use these strategies **FIRST** to minimise all behaviours:

- Proximity control
- Ignore/attend/praise
- Signal / non-verbal cues

If they don't result in a change in behaviour then move onto:

- Redirect
- Reteach
- Provide choice
- Student conference
- Student kept in at interval / lunchtime
- Brief removal from class faculty withdrawal
- Consider Learning Support assessment
- Contact home

STAGE 2 - Behaviour requires the involvement of others (Dean, Pouwhare)

OBSERVED PROBLEM BEHAVIOURS:

- Behaviour that undermines
- Bullying
- Continual disobedience
- Defiance
 - Arguing / inappropriate response from student
 - Not attending detention
 - Refusing to follow instructions
- Out of bounds / off school location
- Technology violation/ accessing inappropriate sites
- Truant / skip class
- Verbal abuse

POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES

- Contact home Dean
- Removal from class*
- Reteach
- Removal of privilege (including access to IT)
- Involvement of Classroom teacher/Form Teacher / HOF / Dean
- Restorative meeting between staff member and student
- Lunchtime Litter Duty
- After School School Service

STAGE 3 - Behaviour requires the involvement of others (SLT)

OBSERVED PROBLEM BEHAVIOURS:

- Arson
- Fighting
- Physical assault
- Theft
- Gang affiliation display and/or behaviours
- Use / possession of combustibles (lighters & fireworks)
- Use / possession of alcohol
- Use / possession of drugs
- Use / possession of tobacco / vaping paraphernalia
- Use / possession of weapons
- Vandalism

POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES

- In-school stand down
- Stand down
- Suspension
