

## Katikati College Whānau Pūmanawa Kaiāwhina

The position of Kaiāwhina is permanent, part time (term time only) 15 hours per week.

The position will provide the successful applicant with Te Reo me ōna Tikanga, within a meaningful journey of connection and personal growth.

The successful applicant must be:

- experienced with Te Reo Māori me ona tikanga
- passionate about engaging ākonga within a Kaupapa Māori learning context
- committed to increasing Māori engagement and achievement levels
- able to work with small learning groups
- supportive of ākonga learning by encouraging and motivating ākonga to achieve

The applicant will:

- motivate non-Māori and Māori ākonga to connect with their learning
- be organised and able to work collaboratively with other staff members
- have a positive outlook that is focussed on uplifting the mana of the individual
