### **Information regarding the Stileapp subscription:**

The 2021 stationery lists for Years 7 to 10 include an item called “Stileapp subscription”. This is an annual subscription to Stile which is an on-line platform built for e-learning. Stile is used widely in Australasia in both primary and secondary schools, in all subjects, from maths to English, PE and music. Stile is used extensively in all Year 7 - 10 Science classes.

Stile permits learning through a social, digital and media rich medium, combining textbook, workbook and collaboration tools into one modern on-line space, accessible by students and teachers anywhere, at any time and on any device

Its ease of use and multimodal nature (ability to mix and match various media and question types) makes it easy for teachers to create engaging lessons and also give students real-time feedback to help move their learning forward.
